\*The federal law does not recognize a domestic partner as a tax dependent. As such, any amount that Green Dot pays to cover your domestic partner and/or his or her eligible dependents will be taxable income to you. This amount is called "imputed income" and you are required to pay federal, state and local taxes as well as social security (FICA) and Medicare taxes on this amount.
